Secretary read report of Reorganization Committee
Mr. Manley moved that: the report be received
and adopted with amendments as follows:

Fourth: "We recommend that in the new organization
certificates of stock be issued. In case of any member
desiring to sell his stock it shall be in etc." and
unless seventy five (75) per cent of the amount be
subscribed by July 1st 1911 the matter shall be
referred back to the stockholders and the subscrip-
tions already paid be returned to the subscribers.

On motion the Committee was continued and

We, your Committee, appointed to prepare plans for the re-organization of the Lake View
Hunting and Fishing Association, having met and given consideration to the subject matter re-
ferred to us, beg leave to submit to the Stockholders of the present Association a report as fol-
lows:

FIRST: That for the purpose of building a new Club-house, detached cottages, furniture for
the same, water supply and plumbing and for the improvement of the Lake and grounds, \$20,000,
in cash should be raised.

SECOND: That this sum shall be raised by providing for 150 memberships, the share-hold-
ers in the old Association to pay \$100, each, one-fourth to be paid January 1st, 1911 and one-
fourth to be paid each two months thereafter until the full amount is paid. New members to
pay \$200 each, and one-fourth to be paid January 1st, 1911 and one-fourth, each two months
thereafter until fully paid.

THIRD: That a two story Club-house be constructed, the crude plan of which will be sub-
mitted to the forthcoming Stockholders meeting and to cost approximately \$12,500, that two
detached cottages of four rooms each, with central hallway, be constructed at an approximate
cost of \$1500, for both. It is our judgment that the water supply and plumbing will cost \$1500,
the furniture one thousand, leaving \$3500, for the improvement of the Lake and grounds.

FOURTH: We recommend that in the new organization certificates of membership be issued
rather than shares of stock. In case of any member desiring to sell his membership it shall be
provided that he place it with the board of Directors for sale at such price as is satisfactory to
the holder.

FIFTH: We recommend that a copy of this report be inclosed to each member of the
present organization with the notice of the forth-coming Stockholders meeting at which this
report is to be considered.
