Governor John Carlin's office sent a draft telegram to John Watson of the Kansas Department of Economic Development for his review. The telegram describes a proposed August 1979 Kansas trade mission to China. In the message, the governor's office accepts China's invitation to visit the country, lists the members of the mission delegation, and proposes an itinerary. Governor Carlin led this and two other trips to China (in 1984 and 1986) to explore potential economic, educational, scientific, and cultural exchanges between Kansas and the Peoples Republic of China.

THE STATE OF KANSAS IS PLEASED TO ACCEPT INVITATION FOR KANSAS TRADE MISSION TO VISIT PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA IN AUGUST, 1979. PROPOSED DETAILS ON MISSION OBJECTIVES, NAMES, FIRMS AND PROPOSED ITINERARY ARE PRESENTED FOR YOUR REVIEW.

OBJECTIVES. STATE OF KANSAS SEEKS TO DEVELOP COMMERCIAL AND CULTURAL EXCHANGE WITH PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA BY EXPLORING TRADE POSSIBILITIES IN TECHNOLOGY, PRODUCTION, EDUCATION AND CULTURAL EXCHANGES. WE WEEK TO PROMOTE ECONOMIC COOPERATION BETWEEN CHINA AND KANSAS IN AREAS OF AGRICULTURAL TECHNOLOGY, EDUCATION AND INTERNATIONAL TRADE. WE WEEK TO ESTABLISH EXCHANGES BETWEEN CHINA AND KANSAS TO FURTHER THESE INTERESTS AND TO ENHANCE FRIENDSHIP AND UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN PEOPLES OF CHINA AND THE UNITED STATES.

MISSION DELEGATION. THE HONORABLE JOHN CARLIN, GOVERNOR, STATE OF KANSAS, WILL LEAD KANSAS TRADE MISSION TO CHINA. GOVERNOR CARLIN, WHO HAS BEEN GOVERNOR SINCE JANUARY, 1979, HAS A BACKGROUND AS A MEMBER OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE. HE OWNS AND MANGES A DIVERSIFIED FARMING OPERATION. OTHER MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNOR'S STAFF WHO WILL ACCOMPANY THE GOVERNOR TO CHINA INCLUDE PATRICK HURLEY, SECRETARY OF ADMINISTRATION, STATE OF KANSAS;

SR. JEANNE MCKENNA, SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE GOVERNOR; AND WILLIAM HOCH, PRESS SECRETARY TO THE GOVERNOR. THE GOVERNOR'S STAFF MEMBERS ARE ADVISORS TO GOVERNOR CARLIN AND WILL ASSIST IN HIS OFFICIALS GUBERNATIORIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES.

MEMBERS OF THE DELEGATION AND THEIR MISSION PROPOSALS ARE:

PATRICK J. HURLEY, SECRETARY OF ADMINISTRATION, STATE OF KANSAS, MALE, AGE 39, MR. HURLEY WILL ASSIST GOVERNOR IN DIRECTION OF MISSION AND DESIRE TO ACCOMPANY GOVERNOR IN MEETINGS WITH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS.

SR. JEANNE MCKENNA, SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO GOVERNOR, STATE OF KANSAS, FEMALE, AGE 46, SR. MCKENNA HAS A PHD IN AMERICAN HISTORY FROM ST. LOUIS UNIVERSITY AND IS CURRENTLY ON LEAVE OF ABSENCE AS CHAIRMAN OF HUMANITIES DEPARTMENT FROM MARYMOUNT COLLEGE IN SALINA, KANSAS. IN ADDITION TO ASSISTING GOVERNOR IN TRADE MISSION, SHE WOULD BE INTERESTED IN MEETING WITH APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS IN MINISTRY OF EDUCATION.
