Interview on experiences in World War II

Ensign Dryden enlisted in the Navy in 1943 and served until 1944 in the Navy Nurse Corps, U.S. Naval Reserve. Interviewed by Erin Hammer on Aug 25, 2006, Dryden talked about military experiences in the Second World War.
