

Interview on experiences in World War II

Leonard Vern Hogsett enlisted in the Navy in 1944 and served until 1945 in the Ammunition Depot. Interviewed by Megan Smith on Sep. 7, 2006, Hogsett talked about military experiences in the Second World War. The 2005 Kansas Legislature passed a bill funding the WWII Veterans Oral History grant program. This transcript is from one of the nine community institutions that received these grants.
