Interview on experiences in World War II

Sergeant Lacy was drafted into the Army (Infantry) in 1941 and served until 1945 in the 35th Division, 8th Company, 137th Infantry. Interviewed by Joyce Suellentrop on Mar 6, 2006, Lacy talked about military experiences in the Second World War. The 2005 Kansas Legislature passed a bill funding the WWII Veterans Oral History grant program. This transcript is from one of the nine community institutions that received these grants.
