Interview on experiences in World War II

Private First Class [PFC] Vannaman enlisted in the Army (Infantry) in 1940 and served until 1945 in the 7th Infantry Div., 17th Infantry Regiment, Co. I; 3rd Infantry Div, 15th Infantry Reg., Co. M. Interviewed by N/AVannaman talked about military experiences in the Second World War. The 2005 Kansas Legislature passed a bill funding the WWII Veterans Oral History grant program.
