Interview on experiences in World War II

Corporal/Specialist Witthuhn was drafted into the Army (Artillery) in 1942 and served until 1946 in the Battery C, 402nd Coast Artillery. Interviewed by Valerie Kepple on Mar 23, 2006, Witthuhn talked about military experiences in the Second World War.
