

## RECAPITULATION.

FROM STEPHENS' "PROHIBITION IN KANSAS."

### DRUG STORES.

If the difficulty is a drug store joint, the owner of the building, the county attorney, the probate judge, and, if the city in question has an ordinance covering the case, the city marshal, are the persons more immediately charged with duties in the premises. Inform them as to what evidence can be had of violation of the permit, apply first to the officer most accessible and most likely to do something. Deliver to the owner a written notice that the druggist is using his property for the maintenance of a nuisance, preserving a copy, and taking some one along as a second witness to the delivery of the notice. It is better also to see the officers personally than to write to them, if practicable. The county attorney can prosecute for selling irregularly under Gen. Stat. '01, Sec. 2459, or for maintaining a nuisance under Gen. Stat. '01, Secs. 2494-2496, or for both in one action, or he may bring an injunction suit under Gen. Stat. '01, Sec. 2463. The probate judge can revoke the permit without any formal inquiry of any sort, (Gen. Stat. '01, Sec. 2452, and wherever he becomes satisfied in any way that the conditions of the permit have been broken, he ought to do it. It is the business of the marshal to enforce the city ordinances. If the informant is prepared to swear to a complaint in the police court, the marshal can get a warrant forthwith and bring the druggist into court. He may walk behind the prescription case when he is not expected, and if he sees the law being violated, he may take the offender right then to the police court without a warrant. He may set himself or the patrolman on that beat or an officer in citizen's clothes to watch that place till he gets evidence on which to swear out a complaint.

The owner may resume possession at once if opportunity offers to do so peaceably. If possession is refused, he may at once serve a three days' notice and begin a forcible detainer action. And if he does

not proceed to eject the tenant, he may be put in jail with him. (Gen. Stat. '01, Sec. 2498.)

If no one of the three will tackle the problem even after he knows that you know what he can and ought to do, make complaint to the attorney-general furnishing him one affidavit or more of the specific delinquences of these officers, and ask him to make them either perform their duties or get out of office. Failing here, try the governor. If this brings no result, apply to the mayor, and point out to him that it is his duty to be active and vigilant in seeing that the ordinances of the city are enforced, and to see that delinquent subordinates are removed from office. (Gen. Stat. '01, Secs. 788, 967, 1099, 814, 727, 959, 1047, 1048.)

If this fails, nothing remains but for private citizens to do the work of these officers. If the evidence in hand is not sufficient, get some one to watch the store and make a list of persons who go into the back room but would probably not perjure themselves on the witness stand; or to go in himself when business is rushing, and see whether liquor is being drunk on the premises; or to go in and buy liquor without making affidavit. By this time it is quite necessary to have the assistance of an attorney in sympathy with law enforcement and aggressive in temperament. He will decide whether to prepare an information and try to press the county attorney into prosecuting in the district court; or to prepare a complaint which he can file himself before some justice who wants the law enforced, and then "assist" the county attorney when he shows up to prosecute; or to bring an injunction suit, in which he can ignore the county attorney; or to prepare a petition to the probate judge to revoke the permit.

### JOINTS.

If it is the basement or the back room or the second floor of cigar stores and billiard halls and restaurants and barber shops that is causing the trouble, report the facts as before to the owner of the buildings, the county attorney, or the city marshal. The county attorney can get evidence promptly and economically by an inquiry under Gen. Stat. '01, Sec. 2472, and the marshal can do likewise through his police force. This is part of the work for which they are paid, and they should be forced to do it or quit. There may be a prosecution for specific sales under Gen. Stat. '01, Sec. 2457, or a prosecution for maintaining a nuisance under Gen. Stat. '01, Sec. 2494-2496, and wherever there may be a prosecution for maintaining a nuisance, there may be an injunction suit under Gen. Stat. '01, Sec. 2467. If the officers will not act, they are to be pushed in the same manner as before.

If the lawlessness has gone so far that the city is "fining" the liquor sellers a uniform fine at regular intervals, not to make them stop, but to raise revenue, this means that mayor and council, and city attorney, and marshal, and police judge, are all colluding with the criminals. For one honest man anywhere along the line can make that policy unworkable. This condition will scarcely arise except in a county where the county attorney and sheriff and probate judge equally disregard their duties and their official oaths, and there is practically no remedy except to press the attorney-general and the governor hard to have the city officers removed by the State, or the city restrained from exercising the usurped corporate power to license. (Gen. Stat. '01, Sec. 5148 and citations under Sec. 2499.)
