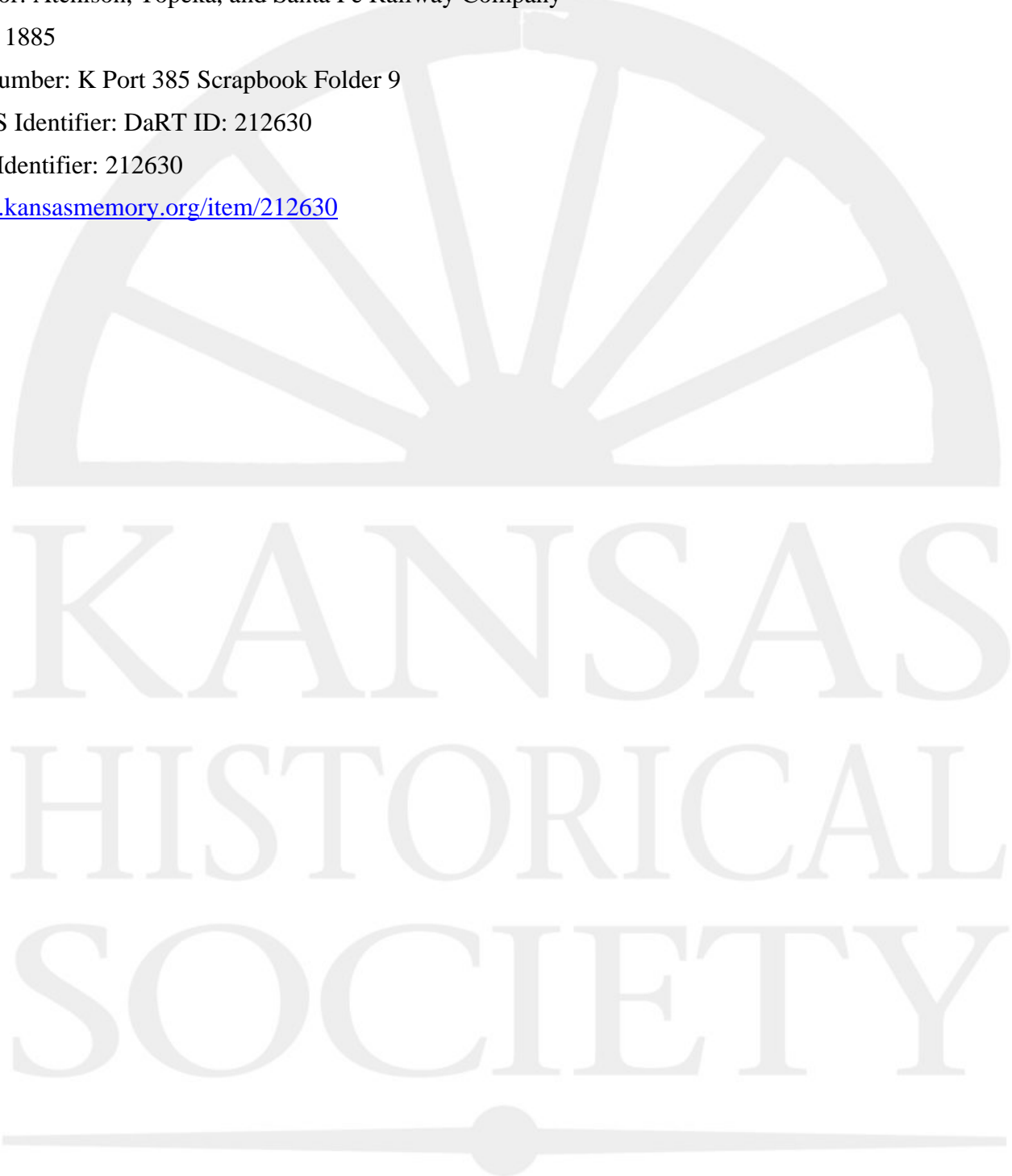

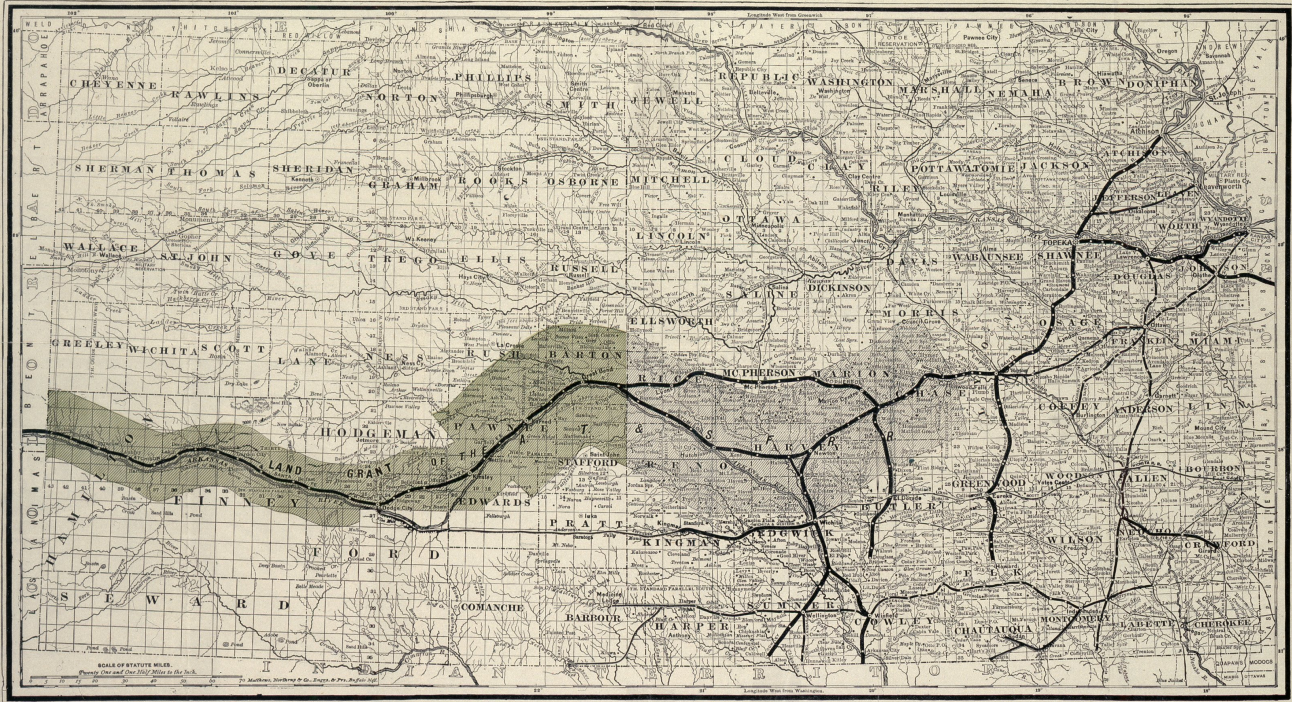

Figure 1. Official Records
