

## Public Welfare Service in Kansas

This item contains 4 bulletins published by the Kansas Emergency Relief Committee (KERC) and the Civil Works Administration (CWA) in Topeka, Kansas. The bulletin numbers are #127 (1924-1933), #289 (1934), #355 (1935), and #380 (1936). The year listed by the bulletin number is the year covered; though the bulletin generally had a publication date sometime the next year. Bulletin Number 127 covers a ten year period from 1924-1933. This report has an introduction, information on the KERC; special programs of the KERC; state statistical summaries; and 105 county reports. Bulletin 289 covers state organization; accomplishments under Work Relief and CWA, special programs in the state and county in 1934; case load and expenditures; state and county statistical summaries; 105 county reports; wage rates, labor relations, and complaints; economic conditions affecting relief load; grants and loans from State and Federal Agencies other than Relief; and maps and charts. Bulletin Number 355 covers the Relief Department, Accounting and Finance Department, Engineering Department; state and county statistical summary; 105 county statistical reports; relief obligations and case load, Homestead Rehabilitation Department; economic conditions affecting relief load; relief appropriations and relief laws; the coordination of public and private welfare service; grants and loans from federal state agencies other than relief. Bulletin Number 380 covers Legislation of 1936, social service development in 1936; case load and case work service and the cost of public assistance and administration; accounting procedures for funds, equipment, materials and commodities; production and distribution projects; Boards of County Commissioners and County Social Welfare Personnel; KERC publications, KERC Audit Reports, and KERC Personnel and Pay Rolls. Also, information on the State and Social Welfare Building, Trust Deed, and the Kansas Homestead Rehabilitation Corporation, State Charter and KHRC Audit Reports. Each of the first three bulletins has an index at the end.

**RELIEF CONDITIONS IN COUNTY, 1931-32**

Marion county depends upon agricultural products for its income, with wheat, corn, and beef cattle as its principal sources. The 2,464 farms in the county average about 240 acres each and claim approximately three-fourths the population. The remaining fourth is divided between the towns of Marion, Hillsboro, Florence, and Peabody, all with populations of 1400 or over. Marion, the county seat, is the largest with 1,810 inhabitants (1932).

In 1931 and 1932 the value of field crops averaged one-half the total value of all farm products, whereas returns from livestock were a little over half the value of field crops. Among the feed crops, oats, alfalfa hay, sorghum, kafir, and sweet clover are widely grown. Dairy and poultry products and wool clip are other sources of income from the farms. The county has 19 manufacturing establishments paying 67 employees \$71,815 yearly (1930). Flour mills are located at Florence and Hillsboro.

Previous to the granting of federal funds, the county had begun work relief projects in various parts of the county to take care of the need for aid. According to the county relief administration, the men were paid in scrip, exchangeable for groceries, clothing, and other necessities. Local committees were organized to distribute the work properly. The federal funds supplemented the rapidly diminishing poor fund in 1932. Local organizations also contributed in giving relief.

**RELIEF CONDITIONS IN COUNTY, 1931-32**

Marshall is, on the whole, a diversified agricultural county, but its county seat, Marysville, with a population of 3,957 (1932), is a railroad town. The Union Pacific and Grand Island division point is located there, with a yearly payroll of \$110,000 (1932). Flour mills are located at Marysville, Blue Rapids, and Oketa.

Blue Rapids once boasted six cement plants and two gypsum mills, but most of these plants are now idle. Other industrial plants bring the county's total to 27 establishments which hire 270 persons annually at a wage of \$327.058 (1930).

Field crops are the most valuable agricultural products with livestock ranking second and dairy products third. Corn is the principal grain crop, being valued at more than \$750,000 (1932). Marshall county ranked first in the state in the production of corn in 1932. Alfalfa hay, wheat, and oats, in order, rank next. Beef cattle and horses are the most valuable livestock.

Marshall county, when federal funds were granted, had a peculiar unemployment situation. According to the county relief administration, Marysville had 250 families left destitute by the closing of the railroad shops; 200 other families were left idle by the abandoning of a pipe line project; only one of Blue Rapids' six cement plants was in operation; and the bad agricultural situation had increased general unemployment conditions. It was also reported that more than 800 heads of families were unemployed on October 1, 1932.

**RELIEF CONDITIONS IN COUNTY, 1931-32**

McPherson county, with two large cities and several smaller ones which engage in industrial pursuits, divides its income chiefly between manufacturing and agriculture. Oil refining and flour milling are the two principal industries. Six flour mills operate in McPherson county; at McPherson (2 mills), Lindsborg, Inman, Marquette, and Moundridge. Only Wyandotte county has more mills, although Barton county has an equal number. The 22 industrial plants in the county employ 136 persons and the total value of products (before manufacture) is \$3,902,143 (1930).  
McPherson county seat, is the largest city with a population of 5,404 (1932). Its industrial expansion between 1930 and 1932 was estimated at \$1,250,000. Lindsborg, the second largest town, has 1,969 inhabitants (1932). Four-year colleges are located at both towns.  
Agricultural products were valued at \$3,411,413 (1932), 65 per cent of the previous year's total. Of this amount about 50 per cent was attributable to field crops. About 65 per cent of the farm acreage is planted to wheat, which comprises 45 per cent of the total grain crop. Cattle and swine lead in livestock numbers although horses are more valuable than swine.  
The county was co-operating with the McPherson chapter of the American Red Cross in administering relief to the unemployed when federal funds were made available, county relief officials report. Crop failures had affected both the farming situation and the numerous flour mills in the county.

**RELIEF CONDITIONS IN COUNTY, 1931-32**

Meade is a typical western Kansas wheat and grazing county. The 983 farms in the county average 616 acres each, and there are only three sizeable towns of which Meade, the county seat, with a population of 1,285 (1932), is the largest.

Wheat is the principal crop, being valued in 1932 at almost as much as the total of all livestock. Both acreage and valuation of the crop dropped off between 1931 and 1932, however, as did total farm acreage. In 1931, 83 per cent of the farm acreage was planted to wheat and the returns from this crop approached one and one-half million dollars, but in 1932 only 60 per cent of the acreage was in wheat and the total returns were but \$315,138.

Beef cattle comprise about 60 per cent of the livestock of the county in numbers and about 70 per cent in total value (1931-32). Dairy products and poultry bring in some returns but are comparatively unimportant.

One of the original 18 drought counties, Meade had had two successive crop failures and three years of low prices when federal aid was introduced. According to county relief officials, finances in general were depleted to such an extent that campaigns for contributions were unavailing. Two hundred families were in need and the poor fund had been exhausted. The county aided with work made possible through utilization of the road funds.

**RELIEF CONDITIONS IN COUNTY, 1931-1932**

Miami is primarily a rural county, with more than 80 per cent of the total land area in farms. In all there are 2,282 farms which average 145 acres each, and only 14 industrial plants which employ 423 persons (1930). Corn comprised 45 per cent of the total value of field crops in 1931 and 42 per cent in 1932. Other important crops are alfalfa, oats, kafir, and winter wheat. Beef cattle and dairy cows together constitute better than half the total value of livestock. Swine and sheep are raised to some extent; in 1932 Miami ranked sixth in the state in the value of sheep. Osawatimie, the largest city, has a population of 4,976 (1932). Missouri Pacific railroad shops and one of the state hospitals for the insane are located there.

Paola, the county seat, has 3,537 residents (1932). Prior to the granting of federal funds, a central control office for poor relief which worked in conjunction with the Red Cross was established by the county, county officials report. In Louisburg, Paola, and Osawatimie community welfare funds were set aside for relief purposes at the time of the Red Cross roll call. The city of Paola since 1930 had carried on a work project, spending about \$2,000 yearly. In the fall of 1930 the Missouri Pacific railroad established a relief program for its former employees which was of great assistance, particularly in Osawatimie.

**RELIEF CONDITIONS IN COUNTY, 1931-32**  
The population of Mitchell county is largely rural. The 1,710 farms in the county average 232 acres each, and the greater part of the soil in cultivation is planted to winter wheat. There are several small towns in the county, however, the largest of which is Beloit, county seat, with 3,385 inhabitants (1932). Because of the large amount of wheat produced in the surrounding territory, a flour mill is located in this city. In all, there are 10 industrial plants in the county. Thirty-two persons are employed and receive an annual wage of \$37,985. The value of the products is \$840,540 (1930). More than half the returns from agricultural products are obtained from field crops, wheat comprising about one-third of the crop value. Corn and alfalfa hay are raised extensively.

Beef cattle, the most valuable livestock, were worth more than \$500,000 in 1932. In numbers swine ranked second, but horses were second in value. Mitchell county once led in sheep raising, but in 1932 had dropped to fifth place in the total value of the animals raised.

Prior to the time when federal funds were granted, Mitchell, one of the original 18 drought counties, depended largely upon the local Red Cross organization, which, through direct co-operation with the county, contributed a large share of time, materials, and supplies. Local funds were insufficient to meet the situation caused by repeated crop failures, the county relief administration reports.
