

Edward Ferdinand Arn

This formal portrait shows Edward Ferdinand Arn ,1906-1998, a lawyer and World War II veteran, Arn begins his career in politics when he is elected on the Republican ticket as Attorney General of Kansas from 1947 to 1949. The following year he is appointed justice of the Kansas State Supreme Court from 1949 to 1950. In November of 1950, Arn is elected the thirty-second Governor of Kansas and serves two terms from 1951 to 1955. During his administration several government agencies are established including the Kansas Turnpike Authority, the State Grain Commission, and the Kansas Veteran's Commission.
