

Effective January 1937, we are compelled by a Roosevelt "New Deal" law, to make a 1% deduction from your wages and turn it over to the government. Finally this may go as high as 4%. You might get this money back in future years ... but only if Congress decides to make the appropriation for that purpose. There is NO guarantee. Decide, before November 3 - election day,
