Dear sir-

Thank you very much for your letter of May 5", containing photograph and biographical data. We are very glad indeed to have all such material of Kansons in the U. 5, service. If you know of any others at your post who should be sending us in such material, I wish you would mention it to them. A time will come very shortly when the state will begin publication of the records of Kansas men in this war, and what we get now is much more likely to be accurate than what must be dug up later on.

Was your son a member of the A. E. F.? If he was, will you send us a photograph of him, together with biographical data, giving company, regiment, etc., to which he belonged.
