

William F. Scheufler, World War I soldier

Around 1919, the Kansas State Historical Society and the American Legion solicited biographical information from returning veterans (primarily members of the 35th and 89th infantry divisions) and the families of those who died in service, notably from the Gold Star Mothers. Each veteran or family member was asked to provide letters, photographs, a biography, and military records. This file contains information on William F. Scheufler, Company C, 137th Infantry, 35th Division. Scheufler was wounded in action in the Argonne Forest on September 28, 1918 and died of those wounds two days later.
