CONSTITUTION ARTICLE I.

This church shall be called the "Central Congregational Church of Topeka, Kansas."

ARTICLE II.—Ecclesiastical Principles.
This church is organized on the following ecclesiastical principles:

Section 1. A church is always to be composed of such as are judged to belong to Christ, and none others.

Section 2. A church is a society of professed believers, united by Covenant, for the worship of God, and the work of the Gospel.

Section 3. Every local church is complete in itself, and has full power to perform all the functions and do all the work which Christ has committed to His church on earth. It thus controls the forming of its Creed, the election of its officers, the admission, discipline, and removal of its members.

Section 4. Every church is bound to live in fellowship, and co-operate with other Evangelical churches, since all alike belong to Christ. In all matters of common interest, the views of neighboring churches should be consulted; but in no such sense as to give these churches control over it in faith, order or action.

Section 5. The members of a church, as concerns their relations to each other and the body, are equal in right, privileges and powers.

ARTICLE III.—Officers and Their Duties.
Section 1. The officers of this church shall be a Pastor, a Clerk, a Church School Superintendent, an Assistant Superintendent, Superintendent of Departments, eight Deacons, six Deaconesses, a Religious Education Committee of six members, a Missionary Committee of six members, a Social Committee of six members and twelve Trustees. In addition

to these there shall be a General Council composed of the pastor, presidents or appointed representatives of the Board of Trustees, Board of Deacons, Deaconesses, Ladies' Aid Society, Men's Brotherhood, the Church School, and at least one representative of the young people to be elected by them in joint meeting.

Section 2. The Annual election of officers shall be held on the second mid-week meeting in December, at which there shall be elected a Clerk, a Church School Superintendent, and Assistant Superintendent, for one year; two members of the Religious Education Committee for three years; four Deacons for two years; three Deaconesses for two years; four Trustees for three years; a Music Committee of three members for one year; two members of the Missionary Committee for three years; and two members of the Social Committee for three years. All these shall assume office on the first day of January following their election. The Trustees shall choose one of their number as Treasurer, and one as Financial Secretary to serve for one year.

The Superintendents of Departments shall be elected on the second mid-week meeting in January (annual meeting). All officers mentioned in this section shall hold office until their successors shall have been elected and installed. All vacancies occurring in any of the Boards and Committees of the Church shall be filled by the bodies in which these vacancies occur. A vacancy occurring in the office of Clerk or Church School Superintendent shall be filled by the church. Officers elected to fill vacancies shall hold office until the next annual meeting.

Section 3. The Pastor's duty shall be to watch over the spiritual interests of the church, preach the Gospel, administer the ordinances, take charge of religious services, and ordinarily act as Moderator of the meetings of the church.

The Deacons are to assist the Pastor in the administration of the Lord's Supper, and in his pastoral duties, and make provision for the pulpit in case of the absence or disability of the Pastor, and his failure to furnish a supply for the same. They are expected to act as peacemakers when differences arise in the church; to counsel, comfort and aid the poor, the sick, and the afflicted; disburse the private charities of the church and to take up contributions, and be responsible for the benevolences of the church.

Also to provide a suitable person who, with the Pastor, shall have charge of the Emergency Fund of the church and have authority to issue orders on the Treasurer for the disbursement of the same.

The Deaconesses shall assist the Pastor and Deacons in the examination of candidates for admission on confession of faith, in caring for the spiritual welfare of the members of the church, and in dispensing the charities of the church; and shall also, with the Deacons, act as a committee on strangers at the public services thereof.

The Trustees are to have charge of the pecuniary affairs of the church, provide a place of worship, and hold it subject to the uses and benefit of the church, (the Pastor always having control of the pulpit on the Sabbath), superintend the raising of the Minister's salary, and provide for all incidental expenses. The Financial Secretary of the Board shall receive all moneys of the church and pay them to the Treasurer, taking receipt therefor, also keep the financial records of the Board of Trustees and accounts with all members.

The Clerk shall keep the records of the business meetings of the church, issue letters of dismission by direction of the church, and keep a correct roll of the membership and perform all duties pertaining to the permanent history of the church.

The Treasurer shall have charge of the funds of the church and shall pay them out as the Trustees shall order except that the emergency fund shall be in the custody of the Board of Deacons to be disbursed by the Treasurer on orders of the person designated by the Board of Deacons.

The Music Committee, with the Pastor, shall have entire supervision of the music of the church. It shall have power to engage and discharge a Music Director, and to make the best possible use of the money provided for music in the annual budget.

The Religious Education Committee shall have supervision of the religious education of the church. It shall counsel with the officers and teachers of the Church School in an endeavor to make and keep the Church School efficient, and, by correlating the educational activities of the church, to prevent overlaping and conflicting effort

The Missionary Committee shall have supervision over the missionary education and activity of the church and shall promote home and foreign missionary interest and giving throughout the membership of the church.

The Social Service Committee shall have the responsibility of relating the church through its individual members and organization to the community in practical service toward the end of good government and social betterment.

The General Council shall be advisory to the Pastor on matters that do not clearly fall under the duties of the regularly established bodies of the church.

Section 4. The Clerk, Secretary of the Board and Treasurer shall present a written report at each annual meeting which shall be held on the second mid-week meeting in January. The Clerk reporting the number of admissions, dismissions and deaths and history of the church during the year. The Secretary of the Board will report the moneys received and paid over to the Treasurer during the year.

ARTICLE IV.

Admission and Transfer of Members.

Section 1. Persons desirous of becoming members of the church on confession of faith or by letter shall be examined by the Pastor and the Boards of Deacons and Deaconesses as to their religious history and present experience and by them recommended to the church for action. If approved by the church they shall be received into fellowship.

Section 2. This church will grant letters of dismission and recommendation to other Evangelical churches, to members in good standing.

Section 3. Any member wishing to withdraw from this church and unite with another should circuit his with another should

Section 3. Any member wishing to withdraw from this church and unite with another should signify his wishes and reasons and first seek to be released from his obligation to this church. Any other mode of withdrawal will be deemed irregular and censurable.

Section 4. Members of this church removing beyond its watch and care shall report to the church, through its Pastor, at least once in six months their whereabouts and their spiritual condition in order to maintain their standing and rights in the church. Letters of dismission and recommendation will not be given unless the above rule is complied with; except upon satisfactory evidence of the Christian character and walk of the applicant. So, letters from other churches will be deemed valid only for six months from their date, unless satisfactory reasons are given for the delay in presentation.

Section 5. By mutual agreement between the church and a member, church membership may be dissolved; the member first, whenever possible, meeting with the church committee for counsel and advisement and the committee reporting back to the church for final action.

Section 6. In case of non-resident members,

whose whereabouts cannot be ascertained, or in case of failure on their part to report to the church after all due effort to hear from them, after two year's time, the church reserves the right to drop such names from the roll.

ARTICLE V .- Discipline.

Section 1. The discipline of this church shall be after the manner ordained by Jesus Christ in Matthew 18:15-18. The penalties for un-Christian conduct shall be private reproof, public admonition, withdrawal of fellowship, and excommunication, according to the nature of the offense.

ARTICLE VI.

Section 1. The annual meeting of this church shall be held on the second mid-week meeting in January.

Section 2. The Sacrament of the Lord's Supper shall be administered once in two months.

Section 3. Notice of special business meetings shall be read from the pulpit in the bulletin on the Sabbath previous, and the nature of the business stated. Ordinary routine business may be transacted at the prayer meeting or preparatory lecture without previous notice.

Section 4. Forty members shall constitute a

Section 5. There shall be a meeting of the church for prayer and conference on one evening of each week.

ARTICLE VII .- Amendments.

Section 1. This church shall have power to adopt such by-laws as shall be consistent with the above constitution,

Section 2. This constitution may be altered or amended by a majority of two-thirds of the members present at any weekly prayer meeting, provided that the amendment shall be made in writ-

ing and read from the pulpit or printed in the bulletin on the two Sundays first preceding the meeting on which the vote is to be taken.

BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I .- Manner of Voting.

Section 1. All elections of officers shall be by ballot, but by unanimous consent of the members present, one member may be directed to cast the unanimous vote of the church for a given (officeperson) when only one is candidate therefor.

Section 2. In voting for officers, balloting shall continue until some member received a majority of all votes cast, which shall elect.

Section 3. In voting on the admission of members, it shall be by viva voce unless a vote by ballot is demanded by two members.

No person shall be declared elected to member-

No person shall be declared elected to membership who shall receive less than two-thirds of the votes cast

votes cast.

Voting on granting letters of dismission shall be viva voce unless two members call for a ballot, and no letters shall be granted unless two-thirds of those voting consent thereto.

ARTICLE II .- Dropping Names From the Roll.

Section 1. A non-resident member failing to comply with Article IV, Section 4, shall be transferred to the inactive list. No letter shall be granted to any member on the inactive list until he has been reinstated by the Deacons and Deaconesses, upon satisfactory evidence of good character. When a name has been on the inactive list for two years, it shall be taken off the annual published roll of the church.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Clerk to report quarterly to the Congregational Evangelical Committee the names and addresses (together with other helpful information) of all non-resident members on the inactive list.
