Three Months' Pay Proper due the Heirs of Volunteer Officers of the late War.

ALL Volunteer Officers of the Army below the rank of Brigadier General, actually in the United States service March 3, 1865, and mustered out subsequent to April 9, 1865, who were not paid "Three Months' Pay Proper," are entitled to the same under Act of March 3, 1865.

The provisions of said act apply only to those whose service was in accordance with the dates decision, where officers of this class DIED after April 9, 1865, whether IN SERVICE TO MUSTER OUT, without having received said pay, the money will go to their nearest relative.
