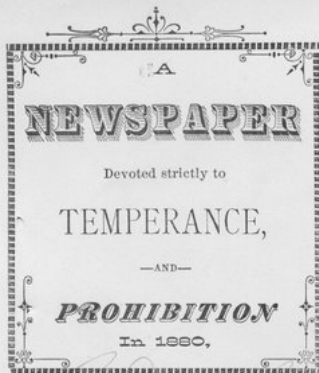

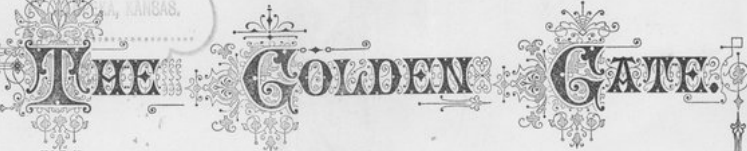

A hundred women were ready to cry with disappointment not only the men but the women all of them have set their hearts on your coming & the disappointment of a failure to do so much dishearten them beyond calculation. Doubt say nay. But come we'll not weary you for a long talk but the sight of your face and a thirty minutes talk will satisfy us. Answer by returning or telegraph of my expense.
