Am sorry  
I could not have had further talk  
with you last evening at Heav-  
-athu but was compelled to return  
on the train. I will see the Sobetha  
as well as several people relative to  
the ground society. I understand Mass-me-  
-ting at Hyde Park here sometime  
after the 1<sup>st</sup> of July & if you can  
arrange to be here I am confident  
we can have a large crowd - such  
a crowd as the people here never witnessed  
here in this region at least on this date  
for it. I have written Joseph Hancock the  
passage at the RR for votes on the  
12<sup>th</sup> for legislative meeting & the 4<sup>th</sup> (3d)  
of July from different points on the line  
as well as other meetings after the celebra-  
-tion during the season. So you can  
arrange & suit yourself as to time after the  
celebration anytime
