

The above cut represents what is known at the Town Company's Brick. It was built in the fall of 1888 and cost \$10,000. It contains two large store rooms below, offices and resident rooms above. It is substantially built of brick with stone trimmings, and iron cornish. It is located on the west side of Boulevard, between Twelfth and Thirteenth street. It is the property of the Sherman County Development Company.
