The age of the black umbrella is illustrated by this photo (about 1910) made by Bert A. Bourne, Delphos, Kan., merchant (1958) of a family picnic atop Indian Lookout rock south of Delphos. Big man at left in "bowler" is Louis H. Cool, (dec.) once prominent Glasco farmer and stockman. Next to him is Bessie Bourne, Mrs. Dan Bourne (seated) Harry Bourne, (dec.) former Delphos merchant, implement dealer and theater owner. His wife stands next under umbrella. Boy in knee pants and caps is Joe Cool, present owner of Cool farm, east of Glasco.
