This photograph shows the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway's steam locomotive #2414 in the Topeka, Kansas railroad yards.

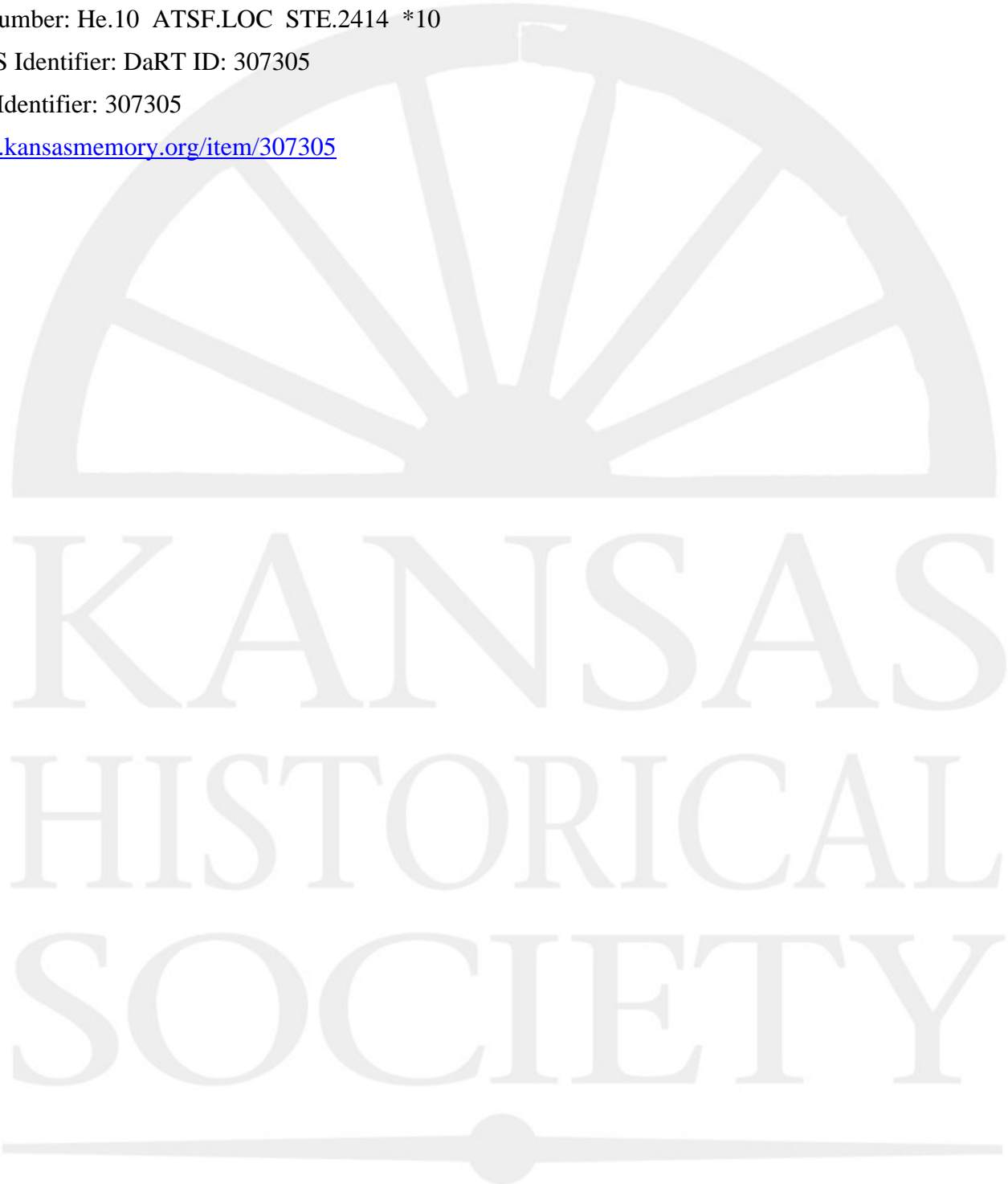

60 odd years of hard knocks and evolutionary demotion through the hierarchy of service assignments-ultimately to the disgrace of Shop Goat, were repaid in full when ex NO. 132 (changed to 2414) was given emeritus status and rebuilt to pristine specifications as display locomotive. Later named "Cyrus K. Holliday", NO. 1.

In June 1941, this engine was rebuilt to its original status and renumbered 132 (from book "Iron Horses of the Santa Fe") for use as a exhibition locomotive. Later renumbered to

No. 1, and named "Cyrus K. Holliday." It is kept at Topeka and was used for special occasions.

I had understood the locomotive to have been No. 132, then changed to No. 2414, then changed to No. 1 and named. In the book mentioned above, it states "changed from 2414 to No. 132, then No. 1."

As No. 2414, it was fitted with a Slope Back Tender. It is reported that the last time it was used under it's own power it was in 1954. Was on run from Atchison, Kansas where it was used to help celebrate the city's 100 years and for the opening of the new Union Station at Atchison.

The new Union Station at Atchison, Kansas is the Last UNION Station to be erected in the United States.
