
I do not have the paper but I have the record from the Cheyenne Leader for June 13, 1874 in which it referred to Mr. Jules Tavernier, an artist from Paris, engaged by Harper's Weekly, at Forts Laramie and Fetterman and the agencies making sketches which will appear in Harper's. Went with Major T.S. Stanton, Paymaster. Also Red Cloud Agency. A portfolio of pictures and sketches. If you do not have it you may want to have it checked. One of the staff members in the department who was here several years ago when you asked for information about Tavernier recently wrote to me from Hawaii that she found some pictures there by him and wanted to know if he was the same artist. So you see your work continues to be of interest to one of the staff who has been married and gone for some years.

I was quite mixed up over what Ben Draper found on Whittredge. It was the article in the Brooklyn Museum Journal for 1942. I thought it was more of a diary and not published. You probably have had it but we have a copy if you have not seen it.


