January 19, 1920. I. Martin, Adj. Gen., Topeka, Kansas. Dear Sir: On January 4th among the miscellaneous bills, which we took over from your Department were several bills from the Long Bell Lbr Co. at Pittsburg, Kansas, and one from that company at Columbus, Kansas, amount \$308.00. In attempting to check up with the Columbus, Kansas, . yard, we find that they have a total of \$911.95 charged against the State. This is \$603.95 in excess of the amount which you gave us. The Long Bell Co. has today supplied us with copies of the invoices covering this amount and advised us that all of the originals of the invoices were approved by Lt. Gorman and turned over to the Major in charge at Scammon. Following is a list of these invoices: Dec. 10th 11th 171.45 loth 123.80 Will you kindly advise if you have the originals of these invoices. If possible, would appreciate your endeavor to ascertain from Lt. Gorman what was done with this lumber. We note that the lumber was shipped from Columbus to Scammon and we are doubtful if it reached Scammon in time to be used as we discontinued operation on December 13th. Yours truly. W/H


