Mw Harry Woodung Governor Jopeka Kan, Dear Sir, your letter of June 30th 1931 was ree, you suggest me to go to the county commissioners, for help. Well they give us 2,50 a week for 3 of us which we can hardly get along with but try to do the best we can and we need clothes for winter, I dide have no work for over a year. and the 12 of nov, we have to mover for they sold our place for mortage, and no money to renta place I asked the county commissioners to help me pay rent for a house, but They said no they wouldent do it told you my wife is sick, with dibeater and had her left legampulatesabour the knee. She has had trouble with her right leg all summer she had a sore toe, and her fool & limb was swollen and causes her lots of pain,

at present she is sick and down with her back and she cant stand an her right leg hardly at all and haint able to be moved do I have to move this wenter, in case of my wefer sickness, and is sut able. and do I have to notify the Partie who has the mortage, for the county attorney would tell me nothing I read in the Ransas City Star That they are doing something for the unemployment people why don't they help here This is nearly drive me crasy, please let me no as soon as possiboly, for I don't no what to do, I am just about down myself. as I don't no what to do so please se and try that we get help be fore its to late, Once we lost everything in a tornado and 3 floods as I told you in my other letter, now am old and nothing to eat for my family, its awhful and can't get no work, I can do.
