ALL MESSAGES TAKEN BY THIS COMPANY ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

To guard against mistakes or delays, the sender of a message should order it repeated, that is, telegraphed back to the originating office for comparison. **You considerate**, whereof it is agreed between the sender of the message and this company as follows:

If errors are made by the company in the transmission or delivery, or for non-delivery, of any message received for transmission at the unpeated-message rate beyond the sum of five hundred dollars, **unless specially valued**; nor in any case for delays arising from unavoidable interruption in the working of its lines; nor for errors in cipher or obscure messages.

whether caused by the negligence of its servants or otherwise, beyond the sum of five thousand dollars, unless a greater value is stated in writing by the sender thereof at the time the message is tendered for transmission, and unless the repeated-message rate is paid or agreed to be paid, and an additional charge equal to one-tenth of one per cent of the amount by which such valuation shall exceed five thousand dollars.

The company is hereby made the agent of the sender, without liability, to forward this message over the lines of any other company when necessary to reach its destination.

4. Messages will be delivered free within one-half mile of the company's office in towns of 5,000 population or less and within one mile of such office in other cities or towns. Dear doctor:

On the 11th instant Mr. B. B. Houdek of Cuba, Kansas, sold a load of fat cattle on the Kansas City market that were found to be infected with mange. According to a letter from his commission firm, Farrar, Davis & Campbell, he has one load of cattle back end wishes to ship them right away. The information is that these cattle have been on full feed 11 months. Therefore, I wish you would go over to Cuba and inspect the load of cattle in question and unless they are badly infected with mange give Mr. Houdek a permit for the shipment if he is anxious to ship the cattle at this time. But, of course, they would have to be shipped as mange exposed cattle and they then would go to the mange quarantine pens in Kansas City and sold for immediate slaughter. He would also have to pay for the cleaning and disinfecting of the cars and loading pens at Cuba and also for the cleaning and disinfecting of the car. If he would prefer to wait until the cattle are treated you could hand treat the cattle in line with the enclosed formula. Mr. Houdek is anxious to have this inspection made tomorrow or the next day. If it is not possible for you to attend to this please phone the office on receipt of this letter.

Wish you would get a man out there as soon as possible and have him inspect the cattle and see what we will have to do with them. If he will get in touch with Mr. Houdek he will go out with him and do everything he can to make the work as easy as possible and get it over with. The cattle have been fed around eleven months and he would like to get rid of them as soon as possible.

Hoping you will be able to get a man out there by Friday at least and inspect the cattle and let him know what has to be done, I am,





Answering your letter of the 14th, and as per our phone talk this morning, we received Dr. Ryan's report of the test of the Calf Club calves this morning, and find that it shows three head classed as suspects.

As stated to you over the phone, the way to handle suspects is to hold them for sixty days and re-test, or ship them to market to sell for immediate slaughter. It will be all right for the owners of the calves in question to send them to market to sell for immediate slaughter at any time they wish, and should any of them want to hold them for a period of sixty days, we will then have a retest made.

Dr. Coffey of the State Veterinary Board, advises this date that he is now checking up the accredited veterinarians of the state and that it will take a week or two for him to complete this work. As soon as he furnishes us with a correct list, we will advise you as to the accredited veterinarians in Lyon and adjoining counties.

Our records show that W. B. Tipton of Emporia, Roy Grinsley of Aulen and F. M. Babcock of Emporia are federal and state accredited veterinarians and therefore authorized to test accredited herd cattle.

D. P. Anderson, Miller, Wm. S. Miller, Olpe, and L. D. Ryan, Emporia are graduate veterinarians in good standing, and of course are authorized to test cattle for tuberculosis, but cannot test accredited herds.

Dear Mr. Mercer:

In response to your request that some one go to Eureka and confer with Dr. E. W. Fitch concerning some horses showing symptoms of Swamp Fever, I would say that I went to Eureka on Monday.

I got in touch with Dr. Fitch Monday evening and learned that the animals were in the locality offall River, some thirty miles from Eureka. We went to the place on Tuesday morning.

The "farm" house and buildings have the appearance of my idea of the Ozarks or the mountaineers' homes. All buildings are of logs and not in a state of good repair. The buildings are situated on a knoll with plenty of shade and drainage. To the North is a ravine and lots of scrub oak.

One of the three horses had died the night before (Monday night). In one shed was a flea-bitten grey horse which appeared to be in the best of health and the owner assured us that it had never been ailing. In another shed was a bay gelding which should weigh about 1300 lbs if in good condition. This horse had a very dull listless appearance and seemed to be in an unthrifty condition. Dr. Fitch informed that this horse had fallen off about 150 lbs since he first saw it about 5 or 6 weeks ago. The pulse was 47 per min and a little weak. The temperature was 99.7°. respirations were 15 per min. with a little heaving at the flank. When the horse was lead out he seemed a little unsteady, he picked a little grass. Age 8-9 yrs.

We held a post. on the horse that died monday evening. This was a black gelding, 9-10 yrs. not bloated, very thin. He showed a very anemic condition. Lungs very pale, no congestion in the lower lung. Quite a little fluid in the heart sac, but very little blood in the heart and the most of this was yellow clots. Very little blood in the large blood vessels. Kidneys pale. Bloody water would drip freely from the liver when the liver was cut. In short there was a well-marked anemic condition without any visible cause and without any signs of any other disease.

I think it is rather difficult for one to base a diagnosis on what I saw without taking into consideration the history as given me by the owner and also the little first-hand history that Dr. Fitch was able to give. I think that he saw these horses only twice and then about 4-5 weeks apart. Had he been able to observe these horses daily during their sickness it would have been more satisfactory than having to depend so much upon the history of the owner.

However, basing my conclusion upon what I saw and upon the history I got I feel justified in saying that these horses had swamp fever.



Answering your letter of the 28th ultimo.

Atchison county is a free area accredited county and of course the regulations require any livestock going into that county for dairy or breeding purposes must be tested before movement is made. In the case of your client it appears the proper way would be that when he assembles the cattle in question for shipment to Atchison county that he would have them tuberculin injected and then have the reading made by a local accredited veterinarian at destination. This would eliminate holding the cattle 72 hours as it would take something like the bigger part of 72 hours to make the shipment from your county to Atchison county and if the cattle are going to a place where there is an accredited veterinarian he would not charge but little to make the 72 hour reading.

They can be handled in this manner, otherwise it will be necessary for him to have his cattle tested before being shipped into the county. Under the regulations, of course, they would have to be sold under the 60 to 90-day retest guarantee.

Following up communication from this office of a few days ago, I am enclosing you copy of a letter received from Dr. T. A. Fowler, representative of this department stationed at the Kansas City Stock Yards.

It would appear from the record that there would be no way to trace the origin of any of your cattle. Therefore, so far as my reports you might have against the serum company that furnished the serum would depend upon the kind of contract that you or your agent made. If the serum company furnishing the serum, guaranteed you against any loss I see no reason why you could not make them pay for the losses you sustained.

I thought we might be able to find out the origin of the cattle as in many instances people ship diseased cattle or cattle out of diseased herds and when we can establish that fact it makes the shipper responsible for the losses but in this case, as you will note, there is no way to trace the origin of these cattle beyond the speculators who sold them to you.

Answering yours of the 7th instant with respect to the shipment of dairy cattle interstate.

Anyone shipping any class of cattle consigning them to a public market does not need any permit for the shipment, unless, of course, the cattle originate in tick quarantine territory. So if Mr. Campbell wants to ship dairy cattle from any state and consign them to the market at Wichita he is privileged to do so and no one can prevent him from doing so and I am quite sure the railroad company will not refuse to accept his shipment. If he consigns his dairy or breeding cattle to any other point other than to a public market it is necessary that he have a tuberculin test certificate issued by an inspector of the federal government or an accredited inspector from the state of origin, the state inspector having authority from the federal government to issue such certificates.

In all instances where it is not possible for a certificate of this kind to be obtained without delay or expense we issue special permits by wire allowing shipments to come forward into Kansas subject to tuberculin test under our direction, at destination.

So far as I know, no railroad company has ever refused to accept a special permit issued by this department. Therefore, whenever you have a request for a special permit phone this office giving us the particulars and we will wire the special permit.

When you wired the agent at Lincoln did you sign your own name or mine? If you signed my name to the permit I do not understand why the Frisco railroad would refuse to accept
