

## Great Bend aspect Vessel from the Saxman Site, 14RC301

This Great Bend aspect (ancestral Wichita) vessel section was recovered from the Saxman site in Rice County and donated to the Kansas Historical Society in 2016. These ceramic sherds were reconstructed by the donor. The vessel has grit temper and a smoothed-over cord marked exterior surface. The Saxman site, a large Great Bend aspect village, was occupied by the ancestral Wichita.
