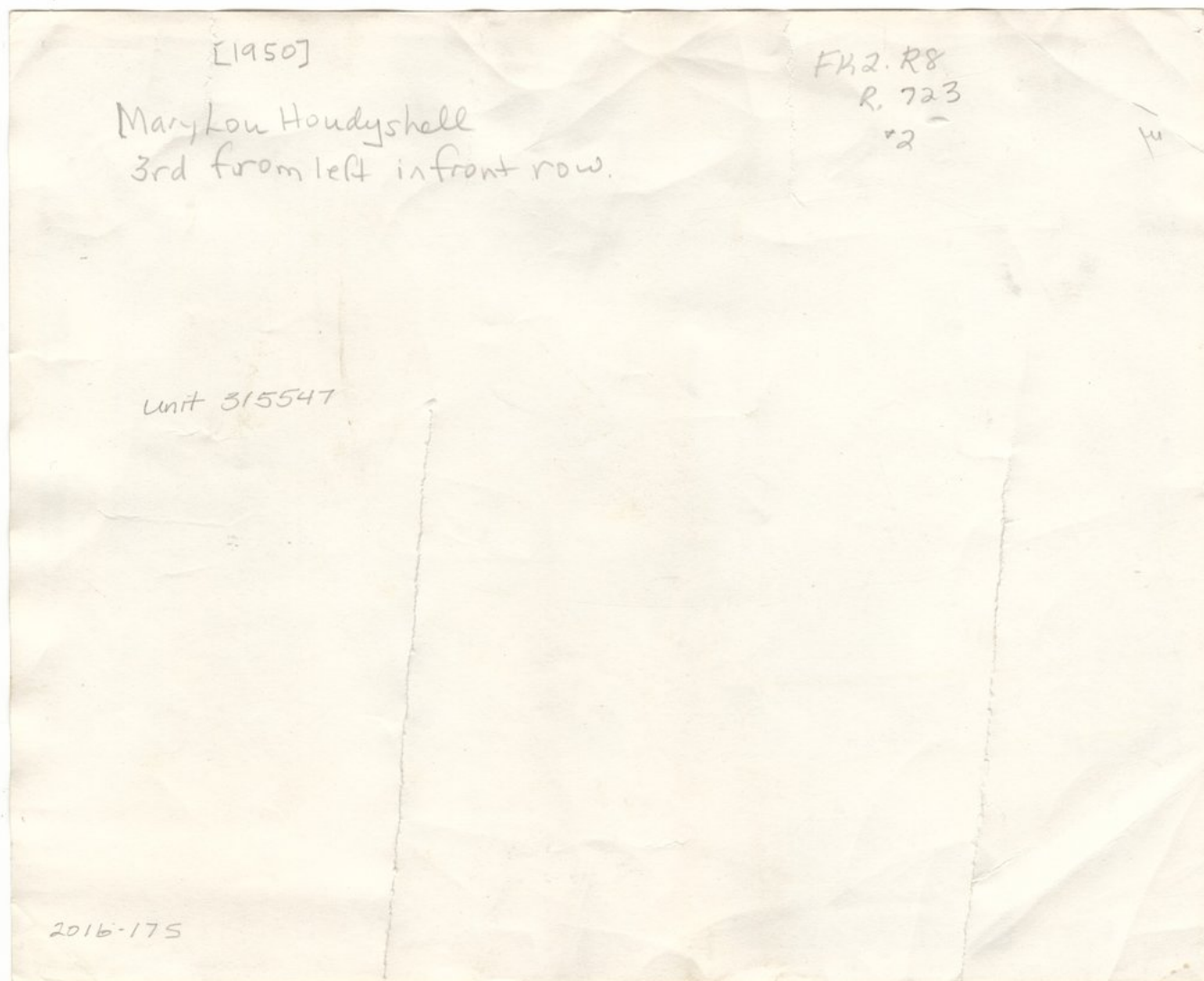

Now the group has grown to 24 and this year the recital will have transcriptions made which will be re-broadcast over a Hays radio station.

At last year's recital the auditorium was packed both nights with spectators coming from as far away as Denver and inquiries have been received about this year's performances.

The program this year will be on the modern trend using pieces like "Tiger Rag," "Canadian Capers," "Rag Doll," "Japanese Sandman" and "Night and Day" as well as a few classics such as "Prelude in C Sharp Minor" by Rachmanioff and "Polanaise" by Chopin. Others on the program will include song and tap numbers by Virginia Liggett and vocal numbers by Miss Ann Hogue.
