Also in the background is the chapel bell house, which was west of Lane University. The University building was used as the Lecompton High School building after 1902 until 1926. back row of team, left to right: Darrel McCall (number 12), Senior; Shipman "Ship" Winter, Senior, (full back), wife was Fay Young; Allen Hickman, Junior (quarter back); Dick Richards, Senior (left half back); Coach Clarence Smith, (Lecompton Elementary School Principal also), never married; Front Row: Paul Tupper, Senior (right end); Fred Davidson, Freshman (right tackle), never married, died 1920; Herman Banks, Sophomore (right guard), wife Rebecca Miller; Harry McCall (center); Harvey Glenn, Junior (left guard), wife Fay Todhunter; John Banks, Senior (left tackle), wife Esther Lambert; Phil Sehon, Junior (left end), wife Dena Baughman--sister of Ted.
