This bail bond was issued by U. S. Marshal I. B. Donalson for L. G. Cleveland on September 18, 1856. Cleveland was arrested by Donalson for "various charges of crimes and misdemeanors". The bond states Cleveland is from Topeka, Kansas Territory.

Kansas Territory versus L. G. Cleveland for various crimes and misdemeanors

Know All men by these presentz that
we L. G. Cleveland
all of Topeka, Shawnee
County and Territory of Kansas in the
United States of America are held
and firmly bound unto I. B. Donaldson
U.S. Marshall for said Territory in the sum of
One thousand dollars, to be paid to the
said Marshal or his administrators, executors
or assigns. Sealed with our seals and dated
the 18th day of September A.D. 1856.

The Condition of this obligation is
such, that whereas the said L. G. Cleveland
has been duly arrested by the said Marshal
on various charges of Crimes & Misdemeanors,
and whereas the said Cleveland is too sick to
be removed and denies to give bond, therefore if
the said Cleveland shall duly surrender
himself to said Marshal Donaldson in Le-
comptan, Douglas County in said Territory
on or before the first day of October 1856,
1856 to answer said Crimes and Misdemeanors
then this obligation to be void and of none
effect or else to be and remain in full
force and virtue.
