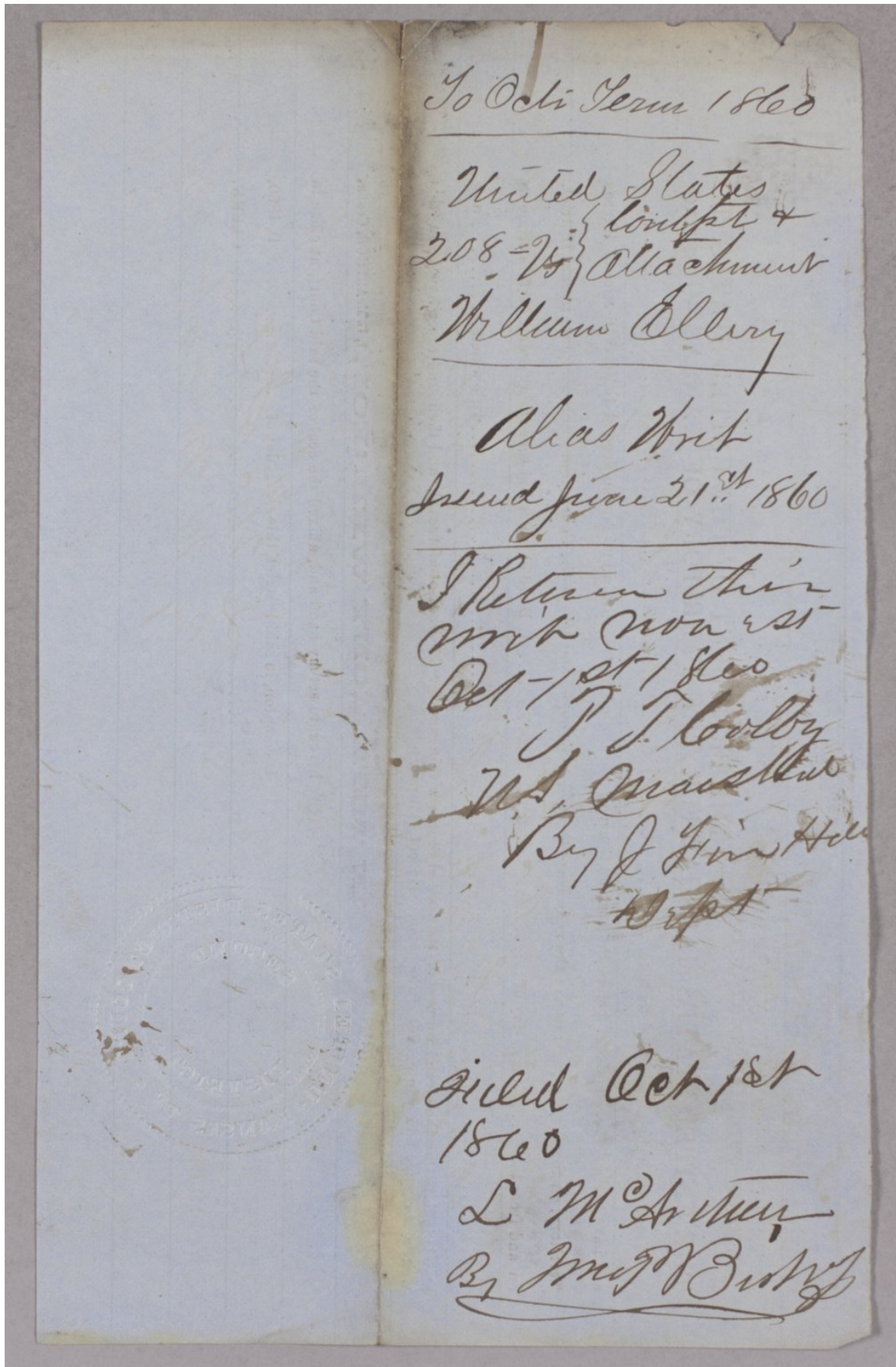

Territory, on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the next Term thereof, to be begun and held at the Court House in Lecompton, in said District,  
on and from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October A. D. 1860, then and there to answer a certain crime of  
Charged, and to testify on part of U. States with which now  
stands indicted by the Grand Inquest of the United States within and for the District aforesaid, and then and there have you this  
writ, and certify how you executed the same. Hereof fail not.  
Witness, the name of the Hon. RUSH ELMORE, Judge.
