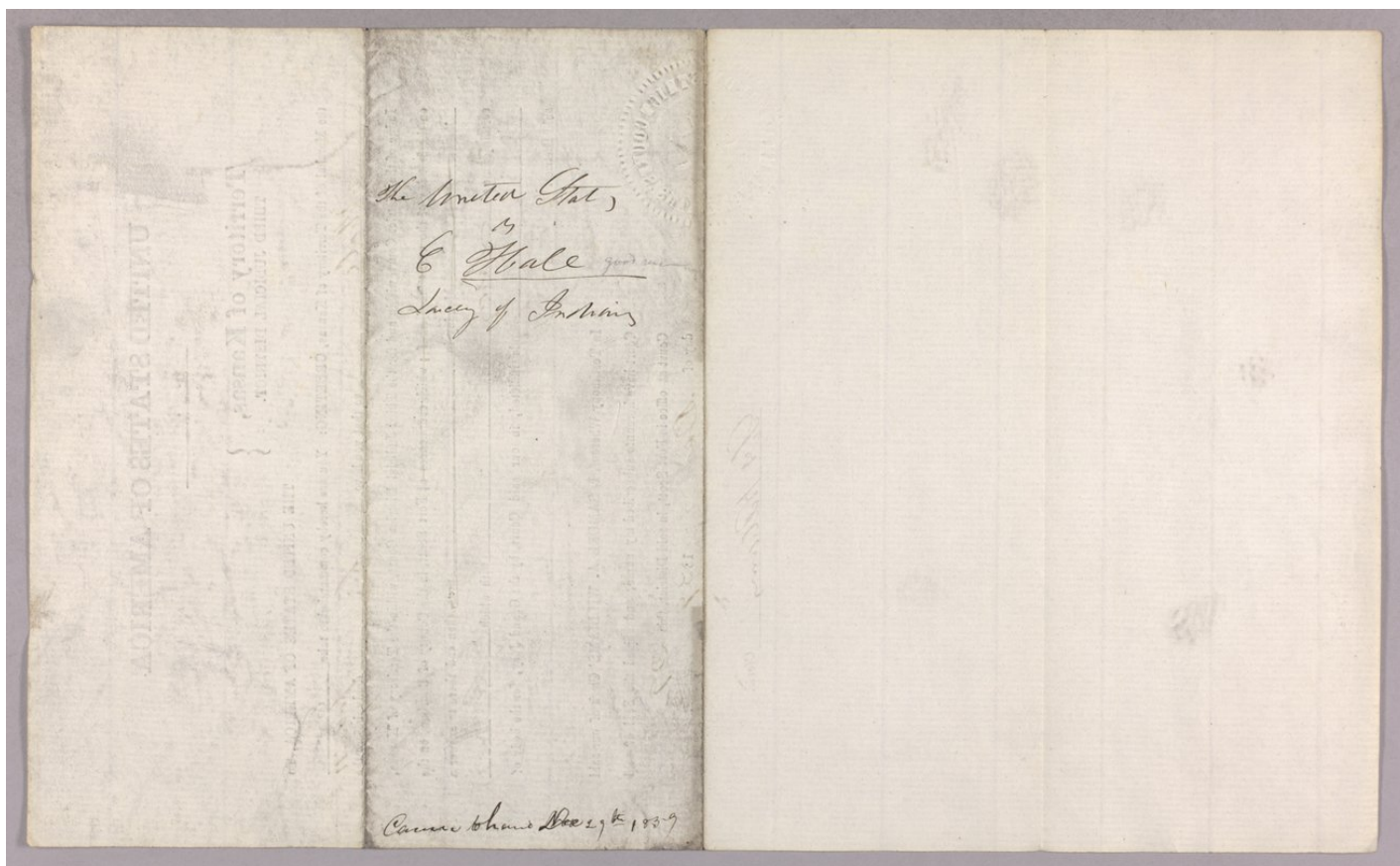

of Kansas Territory upon this oath present that one E.  
Hale late of the District and Territory aforesaid  
on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of **October** A.D. 1854 at the County  
of Bourbon in the District and Territory aforesaid  
and on and within the Indian County known as the  
Newark Indian Reservation inhabited by the Newark  
Indians and within the Jurisdiction of this Court  
the following property to wit one feather bed and  
side clothing two tables four boxes of wearing apparel  
one piece of flour two bushels of meal four chickens three  
one bushel of beans three bushels of potatoes one shofum  
one frock coat one pair of pantaloons one vest  
and one shirt all of great value to wit of the value of five  
hundred dollars of the goods & chattels of one late  
settler a Newark Indian then & there being found feloniously  
stolen take and carrying away contrary to the form of the act  
of Congress in such cases made & provided and  
against the peace and dignity of the said United  
States
