McDonald good & lawful men of the several
counties comprising the District in said Territory

it is presented and indenture is found aga-
inst George Hopkins of said District & Territory
for hauling ^{the} timber away from the school lands
in Township eleven, three & eleven from Section
sixteen in the County of Doniphan in said judicial
district aforementioned

It is presented & found that the said George Hopkins
did ^{buy} haul timber from the school section in
township twenty three & twenty four section sixteen
as above described, and that he knew the
said land was school land and that the tim-
ber was cut on that land in violation of the
United States laws in such cases made and
provided
