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


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


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


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


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Territory of Kansas. The First District Court,
Douglas County ^{ss.} April Term, A.D. 1856


The Grand Jury for the Territory of Kansas, for Douglas County sworn to inquire, upon their oath present, that, Phillip T. Hupp, late of the County aforesaid, on the first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six, in the County aforesaid and within the jurisdiction of the said court, one horse of the value of fifty dollars, of the goods and chattels of William Whistlock, then and there unlawfully, wantonly, maliciously and mischievously, did kill, to the great damage of the said Whistlock, contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the said Territory. 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


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
