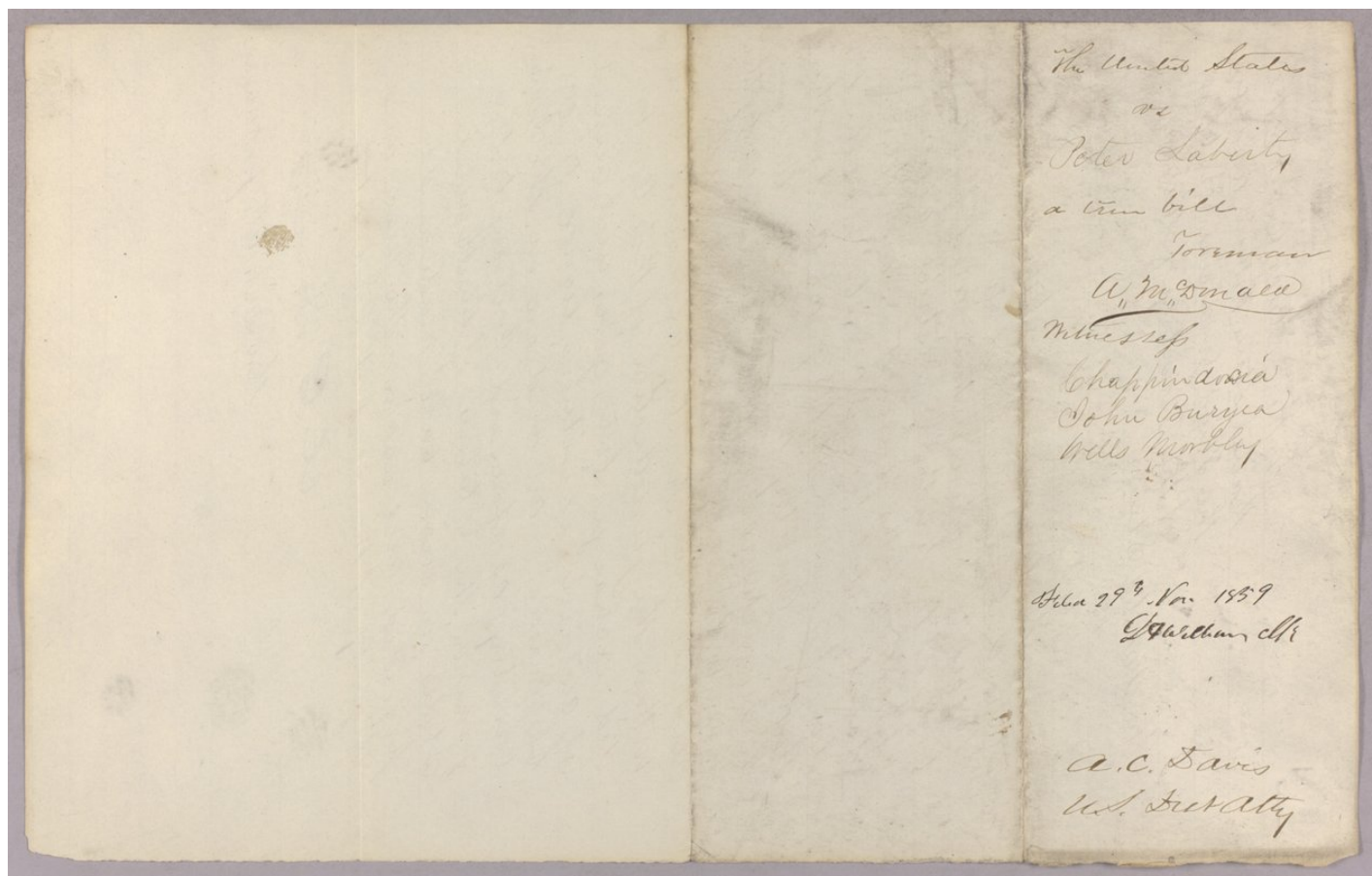

charged to inquire within and for the
body of the Judicial District aforesaid
upon their oaths present that one Peter
Laberty, late of said District on the 1st
day of November A.D. 1859 at and on the
Indian Country known as the Miami
Indian Reservation and inhabited by the
Miami Tribe of Indians and in the
District and Territory aforesaid and
within the jurisdiction of this Court
did exchange, barter, give, and dispose
of certain spirituous liquors to one
Chappindocia an Indian in the Indian
Country as aforesaid Contrary to the
form of the Statute of the United
States in such case made and
provided and against the peace and
dignity of the said United States

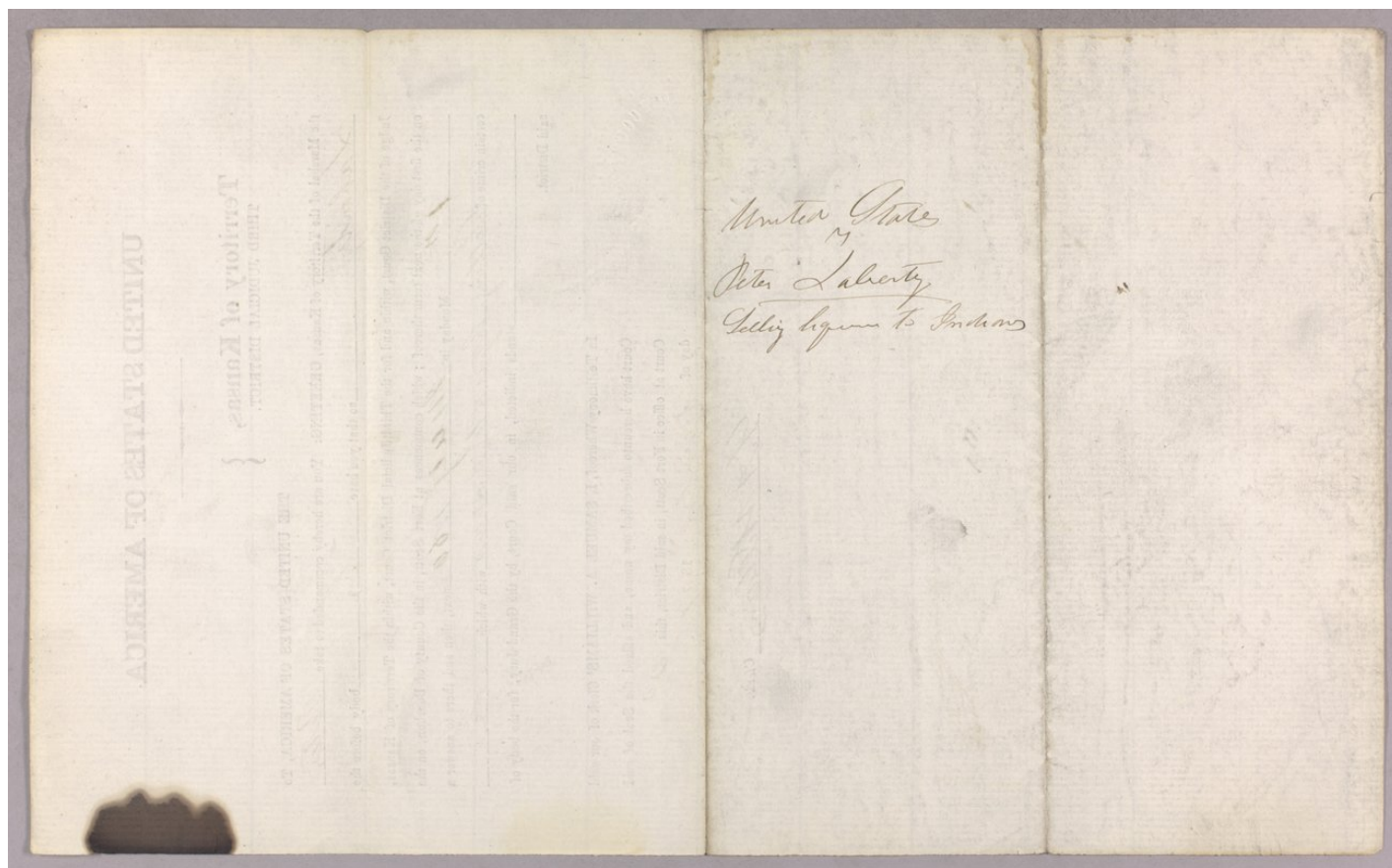
