THE TERRITORY OF KANSAS,

To the Marshal of the United States for said Territory, Greeting:

We command you to take the body of James Lewis, so that you have him before the Judge of the District Court for said District, sitting for the trial of causes arising under the Constitution and Laws of the United States, in the City of Leavenworth, on the first day of the next regular term thereof, to be begun and held in said City on the 12th days of September A. D. 1859. Then and there to answer a certain crime of Seditious Libel with which he stands indicted in our said Court by the Grand Jury of the United States in and for said District and Territory, and hereof fail not, and have you then and there this writ with the return of your doings theron.

Witness, JAMES R. WHITEHEAD, Clerk of said Court, and the Seal thereof affixed at Office in the City of Leavenworth this the 23rd day of July A. D. 1859
