The Sheriff of Kansas
to the Marshal of the United States in and for the
Territory of Kansas Remitting
Whereas on the 10th day of May in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six
are certain Wilder McKinney acknowledged him-
self to owe and stand justly indebted unto the Territory
of Kansas in the sum of Five hundred Dollars, and
a certain R. B. Matney, and E. B. Reed acknowledged
themselves to owe and stand indebted unto the Territory
of Kansas in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars
attested by Wm P. Fair Conditioned that the said
William McKinney shall appear before the district
Court of the Second Judicial District of the Territory of
Kansas to be held at the City of Leavenworth on the
first Monday in May 1857 there and then to
answer to the charge of Selling liquor without
license and remain in said Court until legally
discharged and if convicted shall render him and if
convicted shall render himself in execution of the
judgement thereon pronounced and if he fail to
perform any or either of these undertakings they will
pay to the Territory of Kansas the said William
McKinney the sum of five hundred Dollars and the
said R. B. Matney and E. B. Reed jointly and
severally the further sum of Five hundred Dollars
as by the files in said Court manifestly appears —
And whereas afterwards to wit, ^{at the day appointed} on said Court on
the 22d day of August AD 1857 the said William
McKinney, and the said R. B. Matney

Anel E. B. Reed although severally solemnly called
to make their appearance according to the form of the
recognizance aforesaid came not but made default
whereupon it was Considered by the Court that the
said recognizance be forfeited as by the papers and
records of said Court manifestly appears. and the sum
of ten Five hundred Dollars by the said William
McKinney, and the sum of Five hundred Dollars
by the said R. B. Matney and E. B. Reed, jointly
and severally still remains to be levied of them.

You are therefore hereby commanded as you have
oftentimes commanded you, that by good and lawful
men of your said witness you give Notice to the said
William McKinney, R. B. Matney and E.
B. Reed that they be and appear before our
said Court on the first Monday in October

next to be held in the City of Leavenworth County
to shew cause if any they have why the
said sum of Five hundred so by the said R.
B. Matney and E. B. Reed, acknowledged
as aforesaid ought not to be levied of their bodies
lances and chattels to the use of the said Territory
of Kansas according to the form of their acknowledg-
ments aforesaid if they shall think fit. and
hereof fail not at your peril and have you
then and there this writ
