

of Shawnee - November term A.D. 1856.

The Grand Jury - summoned -
empanelled - sworn and charged to
enquire in and for the body of the
second judicial district of the Territory
aforesaid - upon their oaths present -
that one - Barney Miller - late of the
district and Territory aforesaid heretofore -
-to wit on the ninth of October A.D. 1856 -
in the district and Territory aforesaid
did play at - and bet money on a game of
cards or other gaming device - contrary to
the form of the Statute in such cases
made and provided and against the peace
and dignity of of the Territory of Kansas
