AND THE COUNTY OF Leavenworth }
The United States of America
To the Marshal of said District
Whereas on the 16th day of April A. D. 1859, John F. Murry
was summoned to be and appear before the District Court
of the United States within and for the 2^d Judicial District of the Territory of Kansas
to be held at the Court House in the City of Leavenworth within and for the Term
aforesaid, on and from the 9th day of May A. D. 1859, then and there to appear
as a Petit Juror
as appears by the return of the U.S. Marshal by his Deputy J. Walker
upon the return issued out of the Clerk's office of the said Court on the 24th day of February
A. D. 1859, and made returnable to our said Court at the Term aforesaid, now on file in said office. And whereas
afterwards to wit: On the 9th day of May A. D. 1859, in open Court, at the Term aforesaid,
the said John F. Murry was solemnly called to come into Court, to
defend as aforesaid and came not, but made default and committed a contempt against our said Court.
And whereas, our said Court on the 9th day of May A. D. 1859, did order and assess
a fine for the sum of fifty dollars, for his contempt in not attending our said Court, in
obedience to said return; and did further order and enter up a judgment ni. si. against the
said John F. Murry for the sum of fifty
dollars, and that a scire facias issue against the said John F. Murry
returnable to the next Term of our said Court, that he may show cause why said judg-
ment should not be made final against him. These are therefore to command you to give notice to the said John
F. Murry that he be and appear before the District Court of the United
States within and for the 2^d Judicial District of the Territory of
Kansas, on the first day of the next Term thereof, to be begun and held at the City of Leavenworth
within and for the 2^d Judicial District
of said Territory, on and from the 1st Monday and 3rd day of October A. D. 1859, to
show cause why said judgment should not be made final. And that you return this writ to our said Court on the first day of the next
term, and that you certify how you execute the same.
