Whereas, On the 25th day of October, A. D. 1858, at the October
Term of the District Court of the United States within and for
the Second Judicial District of the said Territory,

For the true payment of which, well & truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, jointly & severally firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals & dated this the 23rd day of July, A.D. 1859—

The conditions of the above obligation is such that whereas an execution in favor of the United States against the said William J. Ott for twelve dollars & sixty-five cents and costs issued out of the United States District Court in & for the 2nd Judicial District of said Territory, has been by B. D. Eastman Deputy for said Colby levied on the following property to wit 18 strawberry Roan Horse 7 years old taken as the property of said Wm J. Ott.


