

Whereas on the 1 day of January, A. D. 1859, Wm Sypes
 was summoned to be and appear before the District Court
 of the United States within and for the Said District of the Territory of Kansas
 to be held at the Court House in the City of Leecompton within and for the County of Leecompton
 aforesaid, on and from the 3 day of January, A. D. 1859, then and there to serve
 as a U. S. Marshal
 as appears by the return of the Marshal
 upon the return issued out of the Clerk's office of the said Court on the 25 day of December
 A. D. 1859, and made returnable to our said Court at the Term aforesaid, now on file in said office. And whereas
 afterwards to wit: On the 4 day of January, A. D. 1859, in open Court, at the Term aforesaid,
 the said Wm Sypes was solemnly called to come into Court, to
serve as aforesaid and came not, but made default and committed a contempt against our said Court.
 And whereas, our said Court on the 21 day of January, A. D. 1859, did order and assess
 a fine for the sum of Ten dollars, for his contempt in not attending our said Court, in
 obedience to said Call
 said Wm Sypes and did further order and enter up a judgment vi. vi. against the
 said Wm Sypes for the sum of Ten
 dollars, and that a scire facias issue against the said Wm Sypes
 returnable to the next Term of our said Court, that he may show cause why said judg-
 ment should not be made final against him. These are therefore to command you to give notice to the said Wm
Sypes that he be and appear before the District Court of the United
 States within and for the Said District of the Territory of
 Kansas, on the first day of the next Term thereof, to be begun and held at the City of Leecompton
town within and for the Said District
 of said Territory, on and from the 2 Monday and 14 day of March, A. D. 1859, to
 show cause why said judgment should not be made final. And that you return this writ to our said Court on the first day of the next
 term, and that you certify how you execute the same.
