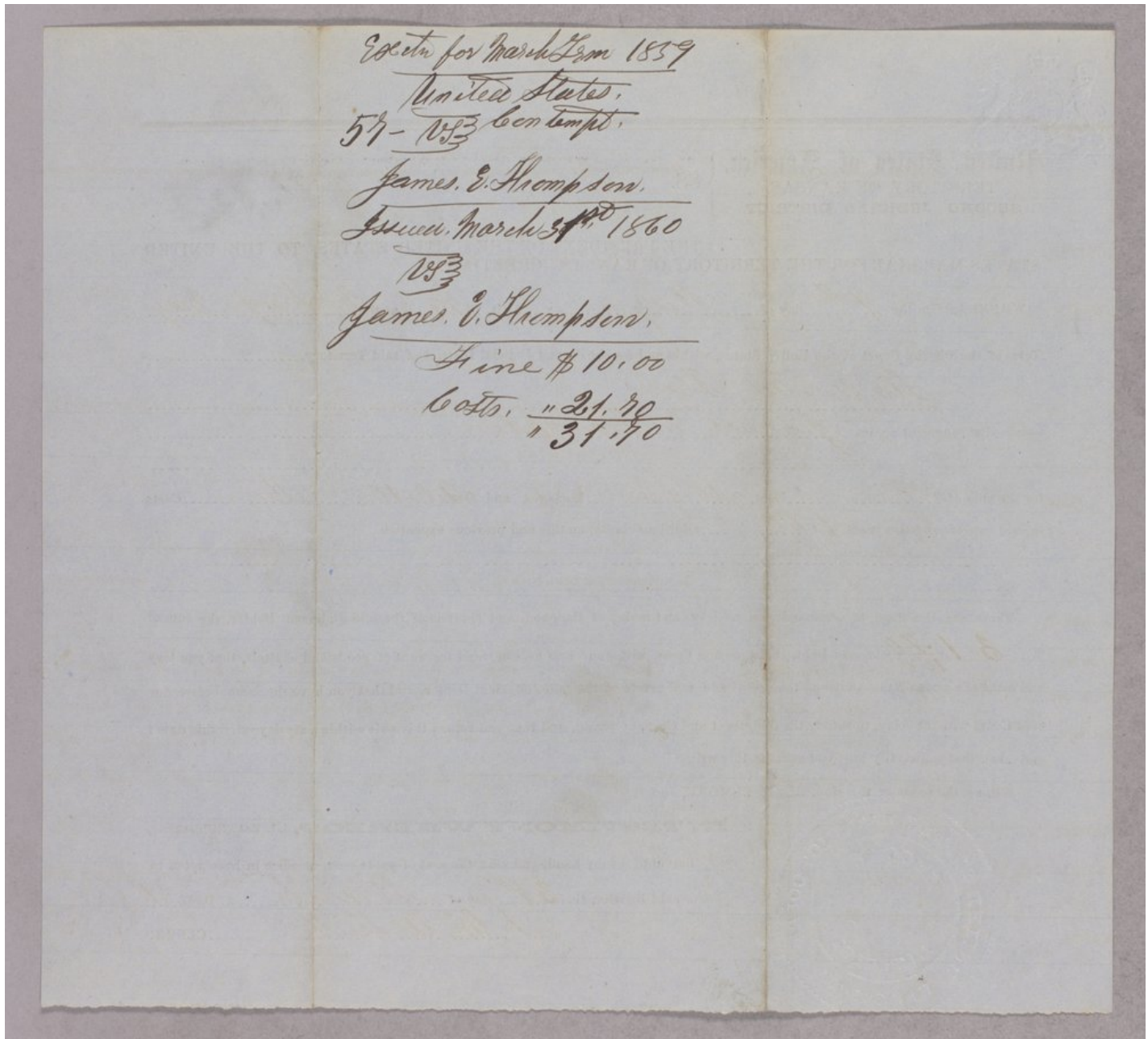

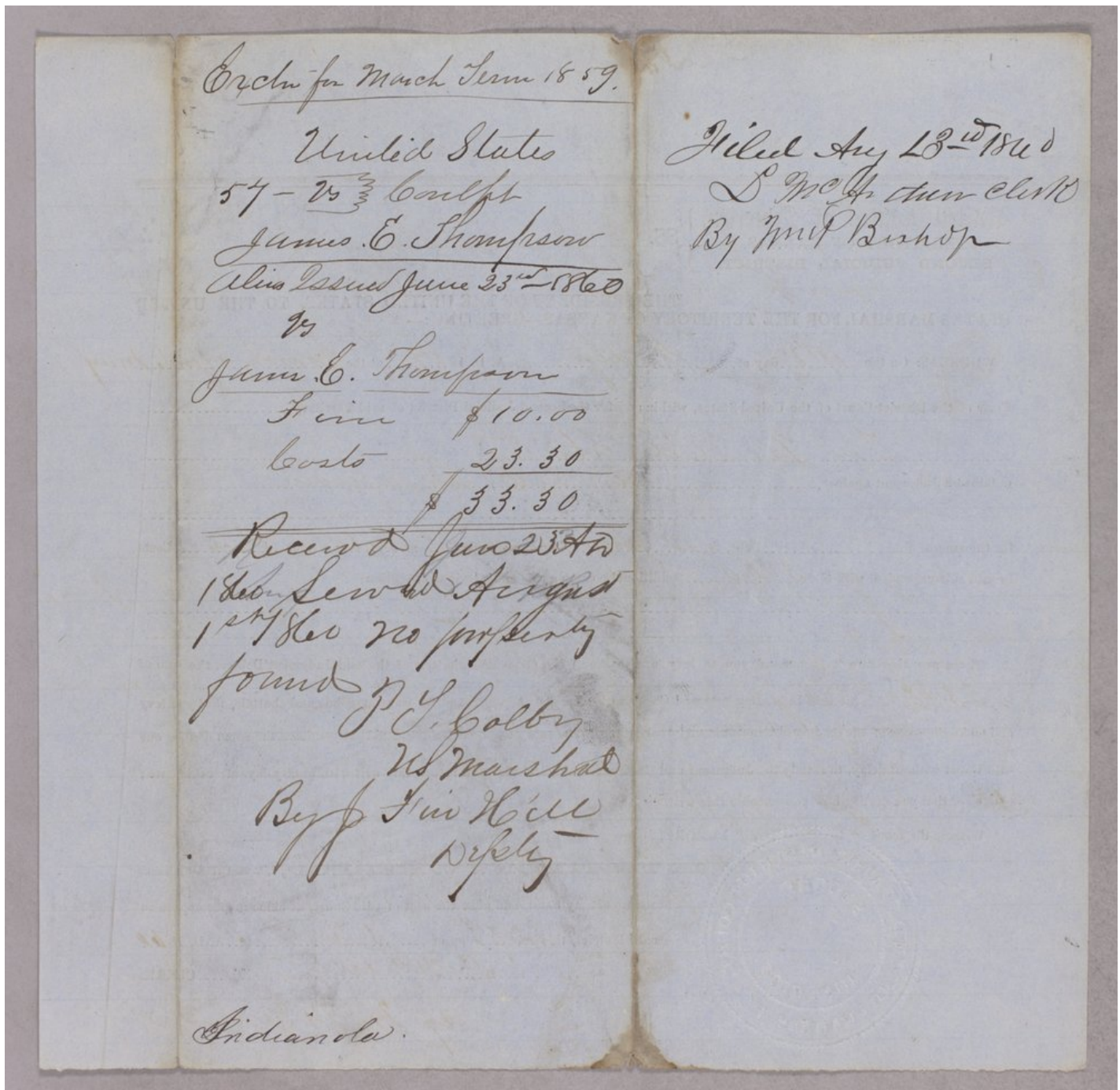

Whereas on the 1 day of January A. D. 1859, James E. Thompson was summoned to be and appear before the District Court of the United States within and for the Second Judicial District of the Territory of Kansas to be held at the Court House in the city of Lawrence within and for the District aforesaid, on and from the 8 day of January A. D. 1859, then and there to appear as a Plaintiff vs Defendant

as appears by the return of the Marshal

upon the writ, issued out of the Clerk's office of the said Court on the 25 day of December A. D. 1859 and made returnable to our said Court at the Term aforesaid, now on file in said office. And whereas afterwards to wit: on the 4 day of January A. D. 1859, in open Court, at the Term aforesaid, the said James E. Thompson was solemnly called to come into Court, to appear as aforesaid and came not, but made default and committed a contempt against our said Court.

And whereas, our said Court on the 4 day of January A. D. 1859, did order and assess a fine for the sum of ten dollars, for his contempt in not attending our said Court, in obedience to said call and did further order and enter up a judgment ni. si against the said James E. Thompson for the sum of ten dollars, and that a scire facias issue against the said James E. Thompson, returnable to the next Term of our said Court, that he may show cause why said judgment should not be made final against him. These are therefore to command you to give notice to the said James E. Thompson that he be and appear before the District Court of the United States within and for the Second Judicial District of the Territory of Kansas, on the first day of the next Term thereof, to be begun and held at the city of Lawrence within and for the Second Judicial District of said Territory, on and from the 2 Monday and 14 day of March A. D. 1859, to show cause why said judgment should not be made final. And that you return this writ to our said Court on the first day of the next term, and that you certify how you execute the same.
