

Territorial Census, 1855, District 13

This census was taken in order to determine eligible voters for elections to be held as proclaimed by Governor Andrew Reeder on November 10, 1854. The categories for information in the census were name, occupation, age, gener, emigrated from, native of United States, naturalized citizen, declarant (intention to become a citizen), Negro, slave, and voter. Only white males over twenty-one were eligible to vote. The districts used for the census were the same as the election districts. A statistical summary of the census followed the enumeration pages. For District 13, the place of election was the house of G. M. Dyer, at the town of Ozawkie. The boundaries of each district were described in Governor Reeder's proclamation, and it is difficult to determine what counties were in each district. The description of District 13 follows: "Commencing in the Kansas River, three miles above the mouth of Stranger Creek; thence in a northwardly direction by a line three miles west of said creek, and corresponding to the courses thereof until it shall strike the southern line of the last Kickapoo reservation; thence along the southern and western line of said reservation, and the western line of the late Sac and Fox reservation to the north line of the Territory; thence west along said line to the line of the Twelfth District; thence by the same and down Soldier's Creek to the mouth thereof, and down the Kansas River to the place of beginning." Districts 13 and 15 are included in one volume [and are scanned as one as it is difficult to determine which entries are in what district].

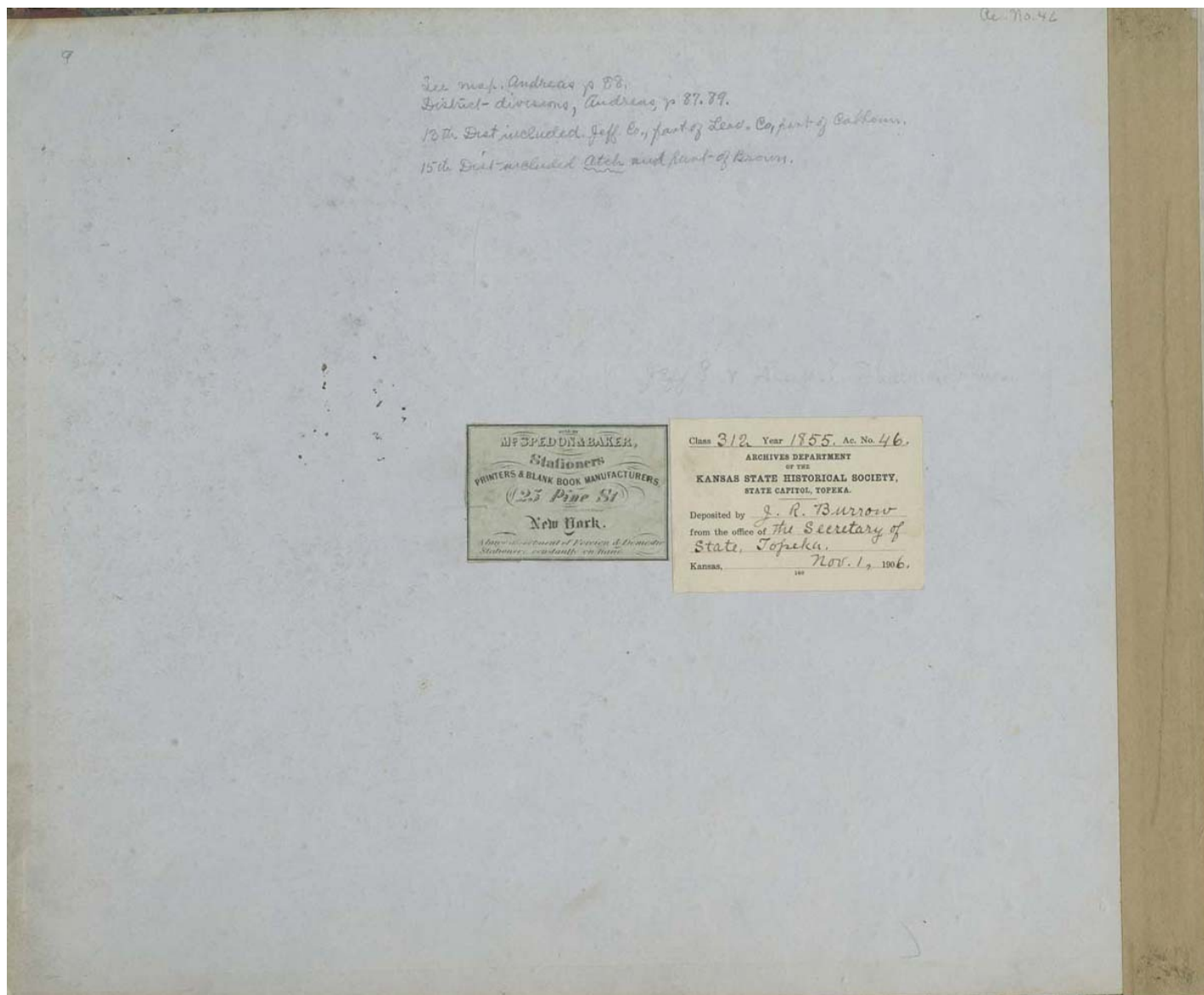

Receipt.

To W. B. Solly Esq.

You are hereby appointed to take the Census or Enumeration in the Fifteenth Election District of the Territory of Kansas. The act of Congress re an Enumeration not only of the Inhabitants but also of the qualified voters and as the law commits solely to me discretion the mode of taking and returning I have caused books to be prepared which will exhibit many features of our population interesting to the public and useful in the way of statistical information as well to the Legislature as the people. In this book you will find the columns prepared accordingly. In noting the age write in the proper column for those under Twenty one, the word "Minor" - for those under 30 and above 21, the figures 21; and for those between 30 & 40 - between 40 & 50 - between 50 & 60 - and above 60, write always the lower number of the two. In noting Males, females, Natives of the United States, Naturalized Citizens, Declarants (meaning those who have declared before some proper Court their intention to become citizens) qualified voters, Negroes and Slaves, it will only be necessary to insert a mark or figure in the proper column. These columns of marks you will foot up on each page and at the end of the book bring together and foot up the several column totals so as to show the aggregate of each class. You will also ascertain and state the total of each kind of occupation and of each class found in the Column of age. The Column for occupation will of course be left blank for miners who have come and remain. In entering the place emigrated from you will name the State or Territory of the U. S. or the foreign Country which was the last place of residence before removal here, and you will ascertain from this column and enter to the end of the book the number from each place named. You will not include any Officers or Soldiers of the Army or persons attached to troops in the Service of the U. States unless they intend to remain and reside in the Territory when not on Service, nor will you include any Indians or persons of Indian blood.

As this is an enumeration of Inhabitants and not of Property, you will enter the name of no man by reason of his owning or claiming land here but only those who actually dwell here at the time of the Census. In noting the qualified voters you must ascertain from your own observation and the best information you can obtain who are entitled to be thus designated. A qualified voter must be free - of white blood. Twenty one years of age - an actual bona fide resident of the Territory dwelling here with the intention of making it his home, and a naturalized Citizen of the U. States or a declarant who has sworn to support the Constitution of the U. States and the Act of Congress organizing the Territory.

As it may become necessary in the formation of Council and Representative Districts to divide your District, it will be well to preserve by notes on the blank pages some information as to the numbers of the Inhabitants with reference to known localities and natural boundaries, or at least so to take the enumeration as that you will know the locality of each part of your enumeration and can communicate to me such information as will enable me to make the necessary notes.

You will also make a separate Alphabetical list of the qualified voters and return the same with your enumeration and classification, personally to me on the Thirtieth day of February next when you will be directed to take the oath contained in this Book.
